- AiM^{-C} GelCaps are an innovative approach to applying insecticide onto cattle. AiM^{-C} GelCaps contains 10mL of cyfluthrin, encased in a unique gelatin capsule.
- Eliminates the need to run cattle through the chute when treatment is needed, particularly when hot.
- Can apply AiM^{-C} to cattle and calves as far away as 20-30 feet. Does not require additional labor or special handling facilities.
- A horn fly study, "Efficacy of VetCap on horn fly numbers," shows VetCap reduced horn fly numbers by over 90% in a 40 day trial.
- A single GelCap application has shown to significantly reduce the fly burden, well below the economic threshold on both sides of the animal.

CYFLUTHRIN Insecticide GelCaps

For Control of Horn Flies, Face Flies, Biting Lice and Sucking Lice on Beef and Dairy Cattle (Including Lactating)

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Use AgriLabs AIM^c GelCaps exclusively with a VetCap[®] Delivery System Applicator (sold separately) and in accordance with use directions and treatment method recommendations.
- Apply when animal is between 20 feet and 30 feet distant from the user.
- Do not apply treatment when bystanders are within 20 feet of the animal.
- Do not apply to any animals in or within 10 feet of bodies of water.

AIM^c Insecticide GelCaps are designed for use only with a compatible applicator device that carries the VetCap[®] approved label. Using any other application device or method could be unsafe, ineffective and/or cause harm or injury

WHERE TO APPLY

Apply the required number of GelCaps to the upper two thirds side of the animal's body, anywhere between the front shoulders and 6 inches ahead of the base of the tail. Where two GelCaps are required, apply one GelCap to each side of the animal.

Horn Flies, Face Flies, Biting and Sucking Lice <i>Care must be taken to apply the correct dosage.</i>

HOW OFTEN

AIM^c GelCaps can be used on beef and dairy cattle (including lactating) of all ages and sizes. Treatment for flies can be repeated as needed but not more than once every 3 weeks. For optimal lice control, an initial application followed by a second treatment 3 weeks later is recommended. AIM^c GelCaps does not control cattle grubs.

NOTICE TO VETERINARIANS

As with all synthetic pyrethroids, a small percentage of animals may experience a temporary skin sensation known as paresthesia within 24 hours after application. Paresthesia is characterized by one or more of the following signs: head tossing, tail twitching, restlessness, and irritability. Generally, affected animals return to normal within 48 hours without treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Not for use or storage in or around the home

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed. Store in original container and out of reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.

NOTE : The GelCap coating is a softgel and is sensitive to ambient humidity. Remove the GelCaps from container only when ready to apply to the animals and keep container lid closed at all other times. Once opened, store the unused GelCaps in the original container with the lid closed in refrigerated/cool conditions.
